He is currently MENA Chapter Director of the Association of International Petroleum Negotiators (AIPN).

Victor is resident and has been working in the Middle East for 11 years. He is Course Director for the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CIArb) and teaches Award Writing. He lectures frequently on dispute resolution in construction, oil and gas and general international business.
